Originally established in 1956 by partners **MOR**is Bloomfield and **BERN**ie Stein as a lamination business, the present day version of Morbern – one of the first expanded vinyl manufacturers in the world – started in 1964, in Cornwall, Ontario.

The rest is family history and, in 2024, Morbern celebrated 60 years expertise in coated fabrics and 10 years of sales in Europe.

Today, the privately-owned family company, now in its third generation, continues to put customers and service at the heart of its operations.

Coated Fabrics are textiles that have been treated to make them stronger and longer lasting.

The PVC (vinyl) coating makes the fabrics' surface more impervious to damage and can be further engineered to resist stains, weather, mildew and other microbes. Modern coated fabrics are also bleach resistant and easy to disinfect.

Whilst vinyl's versatile visual characteristics can simulate a leather or textile look, its inherent fire-resistant properties can be built on to meet specific flammability regulations.

Durable, safe & recyclable

Vinyl coated fabrics are extremely hard-wearing and not prone to peeling or cracking.

Unlike other polymers 50% of PVC (vinyl) is made up of common salt – this makes it less reliant on fossil fuel and easily recyclable.

Large quantities of vinyl are re-melted into many useful products and numerous vinyl-recycling facilities can be found all over the world.
